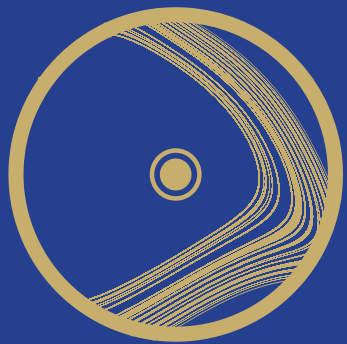

Time Zone:

Local time in Kigali is GMT +2 (Central Africa Time)



Plastic free Rwanda:

Rwanda has been plastic-free since 2008. Please do not bring any plastic, single-use plastics or polythene bags into the country. Plastics will be confiscated & disposed of at the airport.



Weather:

Fractionally south of the Equator & with much of the country lying at altitude, Rwanda enjoys an agreeable tropical highland climate. During May, Kigali's highest temperature is 24.5°C | 76.1°F, & its lowest temperature of 14.3°C | 57.7°F.



Language:

Rwanda's official languages include Kinyarwanda, English, & French. Kinyarwanda is the most widely spoken.

Key Information



Electricity:

In Rwanda, power plugs & sockets (outlets) of type C & type J are used. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. We recommend that you pack a universal travel adaptor & a plug adapter for expediency.



Currency & Payments:

Rwanda's currency is the Rwandan Franc (RWF). Kigali is cashless in most, if not all areas. You will find debit/credit card accepting Point of Sale devices in most shops & restaurants. You can also pay using your local mobile wallet (MTN Momo, Airtel Money).



Yellow Fever:

A Yellow Fever vaccination certificate is mandatory to travelers (Residents/Non-Residents) coming from Yellow Fever endemic countries & any country with an active Yellow Fever transmission outbreak. 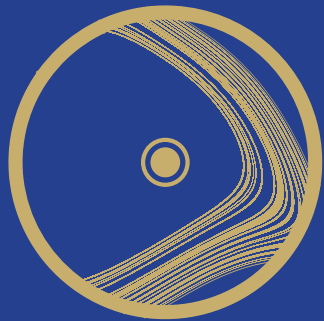
